Pilot experiment on household income

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In fall 2013, the CST conducted an experiment to test an alternative version of the ESS household income question. This alternative wording included a filter question where the respondent is asked to select whether they best know the household's weekly, monthly, or annual income, and depending on the answer to the filter question they are asked the income amount in their preferred format. Respondents who replied DK or refused to answer the income amount were then asked the main reason for their answer. These responses were recorded verbatim and can be found in Appendix A.

Unfortunately, there was a misunderstanding and those who said don't know to the filter question were not asked the income question, so a comparison of DK/refusal levels is now less informative than we hoped it would be. Nevertheless, here is a summary of the findings.

ESS question wording since Round 4

Using this card, please tell me which letter describes your household's total income, after tax and compulsory deductions, from all sources? If you don't know the exact figure, please give an estimate. [Use the part of the card that you know best: weekly, monthly or annual income]

Question sequence in experiment for income question

Thinking about your household's total income after tax and compulsory deductions, from all sources, which one do you know best: your household's weekly, monthly or annual income?

INTERVIEWER: use card [X/Y/Z] with list of [weekly/monthly/annual] salaries

CARD [X/Y/Z] And using this card, please tell me which letter describes your household's total weekly income, after tax and compulsory deductions, from <u>all</u> sources? If you don't know the exact figure, please give an estimate.

When looking at respondents who were asked the substantive question, the alternative wording led to significantly lower levels of response rates in both countries, with substantive responses being 9 percent points higher when the alternative wording is asked (see table 1).

In Great Britain, this difference seems to be due to a reduction in both the percentage of refusals and don't knows. In Portugal, however, the difference is due entirely to increased willingness to provide an income amount (see table 2).
