Brajendra C. Sutradhar is a Honorary (retired) Research Professor at Memorial University and an Adjunct Research Professor at Carleton University, Canada. Professor Sutradhar is an elected member (1991) of the International Statistical Institute, and a fellow of the Americal Statistical Association (2006). He was awarded the title of University Research Professor (2004) by Memorial University for his outstanding research in Statistical Science, and he received a Distinguished Service Award (2007) from the Statistical Society of Canada for his many years of services to the society including his special services for society's annual meetings. He has been a member of the advisory committee on statistical methods in Statistics Canada for 3 years.

Professor Sutradhar is the author of the books: (1) Dynamic Mixed Models for Familial Longitudinal Data (512 pages, 2011, Springer New York), and (2) Longitudinal Categorical Data Analysis (369 pages, 2014, Springer New York). He has done a substantial editorial work over the last two decades. He edited (1) the June 2010 issue of the Canadian Journal of Statistics on a special topic Generalized Linear Longitudinal Mixed Models, (2) Springer Lecture Notes in Statistics, Vol. 211, on Longitudinal Data Analysis subject to Measurement Errors, Missing Values and/or Outliers, and (3) Springer Lecture Notes in Statistics, Vol. 218, Advances and Challenges in Parametric and Semi-parametric Analysis for Correlated Data.
