Dr. Partha Lahiri is Professor of Survey Methodology and Mathematics at the University of Maryland, College Park, USA, and Adjunct Research Professor at the Institute of Social Research, University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, USA. Prior to coming to Maryland, Dr. Lahiri was the Milton Mohr Distinguished Professor of Statistics at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln. His research interests include Bayesian statistics, record linkage and small-area estimation. Dr. Lahiri has served on a number of advisory committees, including the U.S. Census Advisory committee and U.S. National Academy panel. Over the years Dr. Lahiri advised various local and international organizations such as the United Nations Development Program, World Bank, and the Gallup Organization. He is a Fellow of the American Statistical Association and the Institute of Mathematical Statistics and an elected member of the International Statistical Institute.
