1. Create a L^AT_EX document with the following:
 - (a) Document settings: article, 11pt, A4 size paper.
 - (b) A short piece of text of your choice.
2. Add the following to your document:
 - (a) Two sections with section names of your choice.
 - (b) Two subsections inside each section you created in step (a). The subsection names are again of your choice.
 - (c) The subsections should each contain two paragraphs of text.
 - (d) A table of contents to the beginning of the document.
3. Make a title for your document using the `maketitle` command with the following values:
 - (a) Today's date using the `\today` command.
 - (b) Your name as the author.
 - (c) Choose the title yourself.
4. Make an enumerated list of your three favourite musicians and a nested list of your two favourite songs by each musician.

5. Include a verse from your favourite song in your document using the `quote` environment.
6. Somewhere in the document reproduce the following text in the output:
 - (a) The text: l'Hôpital, \$836, Fréchet, 45%, Jyväskylä, C:\user\docs\thesis.pdf.
 - (b) Use the `color` package and include one line of blue text.
